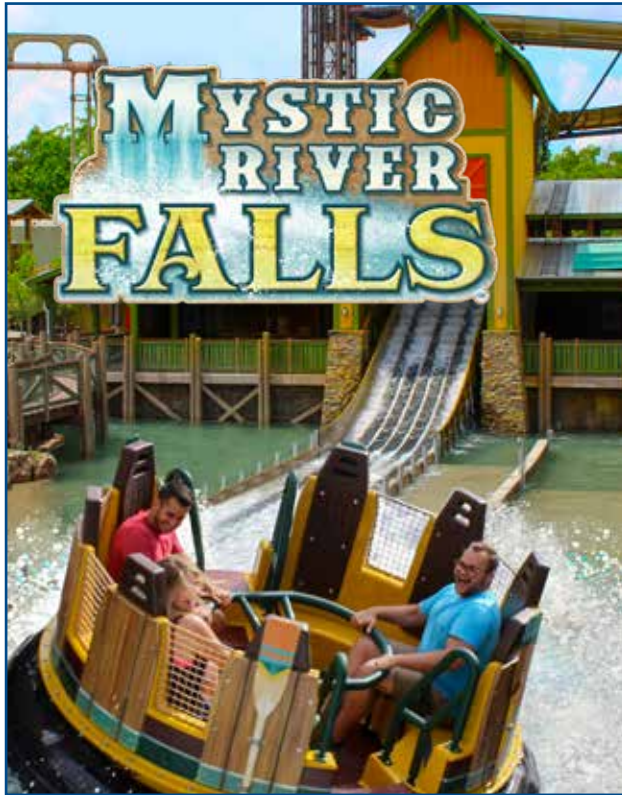

Piping hot out of the oven it melts in your mouth and is now proudly served with Starbucks® coffee if you like...the perfect pairing!



Looking for a City staple for lunch or dinner? Rivertown has you covered with the NEW Rivertown Smokehouse (E-4). Grills are manned by our Pit Masters with 20+ years expertise and our double wood-fired smokers produce 1,200 lbs. of meat including Hickory-smoked Brisket, Pulled Pork, Baby-back Ribs, Chipotle-rubbed Turkey and Texas-style sausage. Plus, kitchen artisans craft signature sides like Molasses Baked Beans, Confetti Corn Salad, Fire-roasted Brussel Sprouts, Tater Tots and Smoked Creamy Double Mac & Cheese! Then your party will ascend a more than 8-story lift tower, while your raft rotates all the while to reveal picturesque views of The City below, followed by dropping into a 6-story elevated river channel before making the final plunge!

## A Rose From The Blacksmith's Hammer

Silver Dollar City has had a longstanding love and deep respect for the blacksmith. Starting with The City's first blacksmith and mayor Shad Heller and coming full circle to Kelly Tiede and Brad Johnson our current day "smithies".

Craftsman Kelly Tiede is no stranger to the forge! A self-proclaimed "ol' plow boy" from Great Bend, Kansas, Kelly Tiede traded fields of wheat for irons in the fire when he became a blacksmith. Having a background in mechanics and welding, Kelly came to Silver Dollar City to work in the foundry and began learning the craft of blacksmithing.

Blacksmith Brad Johnson originally started at Silver Dollar City in the knife shop and moved to the beloved blacksmith shop later in his career, but he's no stranger

to the forge! Brad's story began in New Mexico at the age of 19 where he took to the anvil and hammer at an interpretive living history camp living the life of a resident blacksmith.

Silver Dollar City blacksmiths make everything from fireplace sets and the ever-popular roses that are amazing to watch demonstrated...how something so delicate and beautiful can be transformed from metal and fire is nothing short of INCREDIBLE! Some swear that the roses not only look like an actual rose but also carry the sweet smell. Stop by Wilderness Road Blacksmith Shop (G-5) located just off The City's Square to watch Kelly and Brad craft something extra special with nothing more than a little metal, fire and a hammer!

## Rhonda Vincent In Concert This Weekend

7-Time Grammy Nominee and Winner, and 2020 Inductee into the Grand Ole Opry, Rhonda Vincent returns this Saturday & Sunday for special concerts!

Vincent's music career began early as a child in her family's band The Sally Mountain Show and has spanned more than 4 decades. Born and raised in Missouri, returning to Silver Dollar City is like coming home for the Bluegrass legend as her musical family even played as "City Citizen's" for two summers in the late 70s. And, Rhonda has since become known as "The Queen of Bluegrass" winning an unprecedented 8 Female Vocalist of the Year awards from the International Bluegrass Music Association (IBMA). She and her band, The Rage, are the most awarded band in bluegrass history with the Grammy win for Best Bluegrass Album in 2017, 19 IBMA Awards and 89 Society for the Preservation of Bluegrass Music in America (SPBGMA) Awards.

Seating is limited, so be sure to grab a seat early for these special concerts as Echo Hollow® Amphitheatre presented by Arvest Bank® (F-8) opens at 1:30pm for the 3pm shows and at 4:30pm for the 6pm shows.
